- This does not affect our club shoots or competition shoots at the weekend. The paras will only have the lanes when we are not using them for competitions.

AA will financially compensate us and further support us and our paras, which is fantastic news for the club.

COACHING PROGRAMS

Alex King our Head Coach and Assistant Coach Laura Trezise are launching the following programs:

1. SOPA pathways coaching

This program will run fortnightly starting on Sunday 22nd May from 12-2pm and is open to all club members who are interested in coaching, including para-archers, no matter the goal. Coaches will run through a structured session (Example: shot cycle/ mental focus in the shot cycle, prevention of common injuries, group size and centering) and also provide one on one guidance. The cost for each session will be \$20. Archers who are interested in competition at the state level and above can progress to the SOPA Development team, or SOPA compound team once they meet the requirements. Click here to register

2. Seniors league + coaching

This program will run Tuesdays 10am-12pm from 3rd May and will involve varying competition rounds followed by an hour of coaching. This league is for members over 50 years of age of all bow types and will cost \$10 to enter each week. With four leagues a year the competition will be handicap based and will involve a prize at the end of each league.
