## NEW COACHING PROGRAMS

Alex King our Head Coach and Assistant Coach Laura Trezise are launching the following programs:

1. SOPA pathways coaching - NEW for 2022 and starting in May

This program will run fortnightly (from May) on Sundays from 12-2pm and is open to all club members who are interested in coaching, including para archers, no matter the goal. Coaches will run through a structured session (Example: shot cycle/ mental focus in the shot cycle, prevention of common injuries, group size and centering) and also provide one on one guidance. The cost for each session will be \$20. Archers who are interested in competition at the state level and above can progress to the SOPA Development team, or SOPA compound team once they meet the requirements.

## 2. Seniors league + coaching - NEW for 2022 and starting in May

This program will run Tuesdays 10am-12pm (From May) and will involve varying competition rounds followed by an hour of coaching. This league is for members over 50 years of age of all bow types and will cost \$10 to enter each week. With four leagues a year the competition will be handicap based and will involve a prize at the end of each league.
